

Dear Brothers and Sisters.

God has brought us to the start of yet another year. How are you doing? Is life going well? Or is your life a challenge? How is your family? Are they healthy? Are they home? Are they estranged, rejecting you and who you are? How are you doing?

For many people, the beginning of a new year is a time of hope, of looking forward to new things, new opportunities, new relationships. For many other people, this new year time is a challenging time, full of doubt and pain and the anticipation of difficult times. How is this time for you?

Many of us carry burdens into the new year. Yet when we walk with Jesus we can still live the year well. God gives us several truths about living well. As we enter into 2025, how can we live well? First, to live well, know what you are. You are a New Creation, a Child of God. Jesus was born to make you new, to free you from your past. This is a season of new beginnings.

Secondly, to live well, know how to live – with the wisdom found in Jesus. Wisdom is the ability to understand how the events, the decisions and the choices of our life interconnect. And then wisdom gives us the insight to know how to best make use of them. Jesus is the Lord of the past, the Lord of the present, and the Lord of the future. And He says, "I want this next year to be different for you, to be abundant, so make the best use of the time that I give you. Live wisely."

Thirdly, know who to trust. Trust Jesus. Maybe this one should be first?! Time and again in the New Testament Jesus said to His disciples, "do not be afraid." Fear comes from not knowing what the future will bring. We don't know how the year will play out, but Jesus knows. He has an eternal perspective. And in the face of fearful things, we can trust Jesus and overcome our fear.

I don't know what needs to be new in your life, what needs to be authentic, abundant. I don't know what events in your life need the light of wisdom. I don't know what brings fear into your life. I don't know, but Jesus knows, and Jesus cares. I know that only Jesus can go backward AND forward in time and make your tomorrow different than your yesterday. And I also know what choices we can make so that we can live well, even while things might be hard

In this New Year, remember to know what you are. When you are in Jesus, you are a New Creation. Know how to live, with wisdom. Know who to trust. Jesus.


Anyone seeking membership at Prince of Peace should plan to attend.










Puzzle!


