#### MISSION STATEMENT

We are a family of believers, united to know Christ, and to make him known.



The Christian Season of Lent is a 40-day period of reflection and prayer when we remember the life of our Savior Jesus Christ - specifically His temptation, struggle, suffering, crucifixion, and death. The acts of abstinence and self-denial from worldly pleasures that we practice during Lent provide to Christians purposeful moments to pray, repent, and focus on gratitude. Often in today's modern world, fasting has been pushed aside for the comforts of the modern church.

The ancient and Biblical practice of fasting serves as a way through which God draws us closer to Himself. In his book "A Hunger for God," John Piper writes, "Christian fasting, at its root, is the hunger of a homesickness for God. Christian fasting is not only the spontaneous effect of a superior satisfaction in God, it is also a chosen weapon against every force in the world that would take that satisfaction away." The purpose of fasting must be to draw closer to God.

The spiritual edification of fasting encourages our reliance on God and repentance for when we don't rely on God. Fasting for Lent is primarily a spiritual discipline to orient our complete dependence on God. We repent for not always acknowledging God's presence and grace in providing for our every need. Our God is a loving God, and fasting is one way to refocus our lives upon seeking His kingdom of heaven first in our life.

When we fast or 'give-up' something for Lent, we are doing it in devotion to God. When we experience a desire for that thing or activity, we are reminded of our focus during this season, and are drawn closer to God. We can fast from many things during Lent: foods, activities, practices, even complete meals. But whatever it is that we fast from, we pray that God would show Himself in that time.

During our mid-week Lenten worship gatherings this Lenten Season at Prince of Peace, we will journey through a number of "Encounters with Jesus". They will be:

March 12: Zaccheus - Luke 19: 1 - 10

March 19: The Samarian Woman at the Well – John 4: 1 – 30, 39 – 42

March 26: The Man Born Blind - John 9

April 2: Nicodemus – John 3 and John 19: 38 – 42

April 9: Pilate - John 18: 28 - 38

We will explore how these encounters changed the person's life, or did not change the person's life. Join us every Wednesday at 7pm. And be sure to join us for soup suppers at 6pm.

## REPORT FROM THE NALC PASTOR'S **CONFERENCE**

The NALC Pastor's Conference gathered in San Antonio from January 28-30. The number of congregations in the North American Lutheran Church increased by more than 25 in the past year, and now stands at over 520 congregations. Our seminary network continues to expand in the number of students and faculty. There are about 300 people discerning a call to ordained ministry, ranging in age from high school through adult. 6 full-time staff work in the Texas office. 20 global workers serve around the world.

#### **MALAWI MISSION TEAM**

A Malawi Mission Team for 2025 has been formed and is working toward serving in Malawi from May 19 – June 2. Joy and I, Jason Emmert and Amy Hager are teaming with a grad student from

the U of I and 3 people from Alberta. Primary focus will be 4 days of Bible School teaching, including a bracelet craft for the children to wear afterward. Stories of the students and adults will be gathered. We hope to provide small solar lanterns for high school students for their evening studies, and vaccinations for their laying chickens. As always, soccer balls and other sports equipment will hope to be shared.

#### MALAWI MISSION TEAM - MAY 19 - JUNE 2

In May, Jason Emmert, Amy Hager, Joy and Pastor Andy will travel to Malawi to work with the children and volunteers at the Kanyenyeva Orphan Project. They are



seeking to raise money to provide the following:

- -vaccinations for chickens (\$100)
- -supplies to lead Bible School for 800 children (\$100 \$150)
- -clothing for the project volunteers (at least \$500)
- -inflatable solar lanterns for high school students (\$1,000 \$1,600)
- -flannel for making reusable sanitary products (any amount is helpful)
- -sports equipment (any amount is helpful)

Their goal is to raise at least \$3,000.


#### **Instructions for Logging onto Breeze**


